Duties: The Planning Commission shall have the power and duty, except as otherwise provided by law, to investigate and make recommendations to the City Council regarding review of proposals for major public works projects; review proposals for acquisition of property for street, park or other public purposes; make recommendations to the City Council with respect to the General Plan, a specific plan or regulation and amendments thereto; hold public hearings on proposed zoning; hear and decide applications for conditional uses or other permits; hear and decide applications for exceptions or variances; consider tentative maps of proposed subdivisions; have and exercise all of the powers, duties, rights, privileges and authorities of a City Planning Commission, as provided for by the State of California. Actions are subject to review and final approval by the City Council.

Qualifications: Each of the seven (7) Commissioners shall be a resident of the City and shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

Terms: Appointments are made for two year terms and members may be reappointed.
